CBC-APTN Early Stage Scripted Development Program - Application Requirements Checklist 2024-2025

- Eligibility Form**
 - Applicants will determine their eligibility to the program once they complete this form.

- Applicant Information Form**
 - Applicants will provide information about their organizational structure, such as complete incorporation documents and shareholder registry, board of directors (if applicable), contact information, Statement of Indigenous Identity, etc.;
 - Applicants should ensure this information is accurate. If the Applicant is successful, the organization name must match the signatory of the funding agreement.

- Project Information Form**
 - Applicants will provide details on their proposed project including, but not limited to: title of project, total estimated episodes, total estimated running time per episode, confirmed funding (if applicable), etc.

- CBC-APTN Early Stage Scripted Development application**
 - Applicants will provide written answers describing themselves or company, their proposed project including log line and synopsis, what type of support they need to further develop their project, what work has been done so far to develop their project (if any), if applicant doesn't have a producer attached who would they want to bring on in this role, etc.

- Bio(s) of Applicant(s)**
 - Applicants will provide an updated bio of themselves and any key creatives attached to their proposed project.

- CV or resume for Applicant(s)**



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- Applicants will provide an update CV or resume for themselves and any key creatives attached to their proposed project.

- Pitch Document**
 - Applicants will provide a pitch document detailing their proposed project, including but not limited to: audience, tone, genre, characters, key environment, story, etc.

- Chain of Title or IP agreement**
 - Applicants will provide a current IP agreement/contract to Produce the project in the name of the applicant.

- Short Pitch Video (optional)**
 - Applicants have the option to provide a short pitch video. This should be no longer than 1 to 2 minutes.

- Letter(s) of Support (optional)**
 - Applicants have the option of providing support letters for their project and/or their application.

- Application Requirements Checklist**
 - Applicants will be asked to fill out a final checklist to ensure they have submitted all the required documentation and provided all necessary information.

- Voluntary Personal Data (optional)**
 - Applicants have the option to provide data regarding their identity, geographic location, etc.

- ISO Declaration**
 - Applicants will review and sign the declaration in order to submit their application.
